

## **GenU System**

### **Background**

The UKGTN and professional organisations, ACGS (formerly CMGS and ACC), have worked jointly in the development of the GenUs for a number of years. As both organisations contribute, the GenU system is considered jointly owned with each organisation having different responsibilities for the system.

### **Organisational Responsibilities**

#### ACGS

- Provides professional and scientific endorsement
- Act as first point of contact with membership regarding proposed amendments to GenU System
- Proposes amendments to the system for UKGTN to administer
- Informs UKGTN of queries on assignment of tests within GenU bands
- Disseminates GenU system to ACGS members

#### UKGTN

- Implementation and administration of the system including version control
- Quality reviews through the UKGTN annual data collection and laboratory EQA submissions
- Respond to membership regarding assignment of tests within the current system
- Disseminate GenU system to UKGTN members

### **Process**

- ACGS proposes amendments to UKGTN Laboratory and Membership and Audit (LMA) Working Group
- LMA review, discuss with ACGS as required and sign off amendments
- Final approved GenUs disseminated by UKGTN and ACGS to their members

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
